



ROPE ACCESS SERVICES Overhead Hazard Removal

The Problem

- The diffusers in the existing ducting system were presenting an overhead hazard to workers below due to possible failure.
- Brock was tasked with removing these hazards.
- Rope access was used to access the work area, the diffusers were cut out and lowered to eliminate the overhead hazard.

Project Summary

- Over a 7-day period, 16 diffusers were removed and lowered.
- No operational interferences were experienced during this project.
- Cost savings for this work scope totalled \$54,527.
